## Hardy (HB 31)

<u>Existing law</u> requires the State Board of Elementary and Secondary Education (BESE) to adopt a policy requiring, as a minimum, that the La. High School Athletic Association's (LHSAA) scholastic rule (relative to minimum academic requirements for participation in athletics) be adhered to by all high schools under its jurisdiction.

<u>Prior law</u> required adherence to a 1984 rule, which required a 1.5 grade point average. <u>New</u> <u>law</u> requires adherence to a 2010 rule, which requires a "C" average.

<u>Prior law</u> required BESE annually to review the association's policy and to adopt rules to ensure that such minimum standards be maintained or upgraded. <u>New law</u> removes this requirement.

Effective upon signature of governor (June 20, 2011).
