Smith (SB 31) Act No. 324

<u>Prior law</u> established and provided for a mayor's court for the town of New Llano. <u>Prior law</u>, applicable to mayor's courts generally, authorized the mayor, as presiding officer of the court, to impose court costs not to exceed \$30 dollars for each offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and further provides that in addition to the court costs authorized by <u>prior law</u>, the mayor, as the presiding officer of the court of the town of New Llano, may impose additional court costs not to exceed \$20 dollars for each offense, as defined by ordinance, on any defendant convicted of a violation of a municipal ordinance.
