## Thompson (SB 181)

<u>Prior law</u> required every person who operates a motor vehicle which is designated as being in either Class "A", "B", "C", "D", or "E" by R.S. 32:408 to secure the appropriately classified driver's license with all necessary endorsements before driving or operating any such motor vehicle on any public street, road, or highway of this state.

<u>New law</u> retains <u>prior law</u> and provides a licensing exception from <u>prior law</u> for an operator of an emergency command post vehicle which meets the definition of a commercial motor vehicle and who is employed by the Governor's Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Preparedness or a parish office of emergency preparedness.

<u>New law</u> provides that such operator is only required to have a Class "E" driver's license.

Effective June 28, 2011.
