DIGEST

Proposed law provides that, notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, any records or reports, including arrest reports and adjudication information relating to a child shall be open and available to the public if the child is adjudicated a delinquent of a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) and the child was at least fourteen years of age at the time of the commission of the delinquent act.

Proposed law requires that all medical, psychiatric, and psychological evaluations remain confidential along with any information in the records and reports relating to any other child.

Effective August 1, 2012.
