HOUSE BILL NO. 280

APPROPRIATIONS/JUDGMENT: Appropriates funds for payment of judgment in the matter of "Robert Evangelist v. State of Louisiana through DOTD, et al"

1 AN ACT

2 To appropriate funds out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-
3 2013 to be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Robert Evangelist
4 v. State of Louisiana through the Department of Transportation and Development,
5 Mississippi River Bridge Authority, B&B Electromatic, Inc. and/or B&B ARMR
6 Corporation"; and to provide for related matters.

7 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

8 Section 1. The sum of Twenty Thousand and No/100 (\$20,000.00) Dollars is hereby
9 appropriated out of the General Fund of the state of Louisiana for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 to
10 be used to pay the consent judgment in the suit entitled "Robert Evangelist v. State of
11 Louisiana through the Department of Transportation and Development, Mississippi River
12 Bridge Authority, B&B Electromatic, Inc. and/or B&B ARMR Corporation", bearing
13 Number 2005-12142, Division "H", Section 12, on the docket of the Civil District Court,
14 parish of Orleans, state of Louisiana.

15 Section 2. This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2012; if vetoed by the governor
16 and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on July 1,
17 2012, or on the day following such approval by the legislature, whichever is later.
