MUNICIPALITIES. Provides for ordinances to annex territory owned by a public body.

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 33:180(C), relative to annexation of certain property; to provide
3 relative to the prohibition of annexing certain property by a municipality; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 33:180(C) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §180. Ordinance to annex territory owned by a public body

8 * * *

9 C. ~~A No municipality may annex a portion of the right-of-way of a public~~
10 ~~road as a corridor connecting other property which is not contiguous to the~~
11 ~~municipality but which is to be annexed without including the property adjacent to~~
12 ~~the corridor. Any annexation pursuant to this Subsection shall be in accordance with~~
13 ~~the following:~~

14 ~~(1) The municipality shall, by certified mail, notify the state agency or~~
15 ~~political subdivision which owns the road proposed to be annexed at least thirty days~~
16 ~~prior to the introduction of the ordinance proposing such annexation.~~

17 ~~(2) The petition or written consent of the state agency or political subdivision~~

1 ~~must be received by the municipality prior to the adoption of the ordinance.~~

DIGEST

Present law provides for a municipality to annex a portion of the right-of-way of a public road as a corridor connecting other property which is not contiguous to the municipality but which is to be annexed without including the property adjacent to the corridor.

Proposed law prohibits a municipality from annexing a portion of the right-of-way of a public road as a corridor connecting other property which is not contiguous to the municipality.

Effective August 1, 2012.
