TRANSPORTATION DEPT: Provides relative to topographical mapping

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 48:36, relative to topographic mapping; to provide for mandatory
3 development and maintenance of a statewide digital geospatial database; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 48:36 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §36. Topographic mapping

8 A. The department ~~may~~ shall develop and maintain a statewide digital
9 geospatial database. The department shall act as authority for geographic names, set
10 standards for the mapping of topographic features, and plan and manage data
11 collection for incorporation into a statewide database. Rules and regulations shall
12 be promulgated by the department in accordance with the Administrative Procedure
13 Act as are necessary for the planning and managing of the geospatial data.

14 B. The department shall submit a written report to the House and Senate
15 committees on transportation, highways, and public works providing for a program
16 and plan of implementation for the development and maintenance of a statewide
17 digital geospatial database as required by Subsection A of this Section no later than
18 December 31, 2012.
