COLLEGES/SOUTHERN U: Authorizes a tuition increase at Southern University Laboratory School

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 17:1855.2(3), relative to tuition increases at Southern University Laboratory
3 School; to authorize a tuition increase; and to provide for related matters.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 17:1855.2(3) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

6 §1855.2. Southern University Laboratory School; tuition; increase; amounts

7 In addition to the authority granted to the Board of Supervisors of Southern
8 University and Agricultural and Mechanical College by R.S. 17:1855, 1855.1,
9 3351(A)(5), and 3351.1 and in accordance with Article VII, Section 2.1(A) of the
10 Constitution of Louisiana, the board may increase the amount of tuition charged per
11 student at the university laboratory school by the following amounts:

13 (3) For the 2012-2013 school year and thereafter, by an additional amount
14 not to exceed five hundred dollars.

Abstract: Authorizes the Southern University Board of Supervisors to increase the tuition charged per student at the university laboratory school by no more than \$500.

Present law authorizes the Southern University Board of Supervisors to increase the amount of tuition charged per student at the university laboratory school by the following amounts:

- (1) For the 2006-2007 school year and thereafter, by an amount not to exceed \$500.
- (2) For the 2007-2008 school year and thereafter, by an additional amount not to exceed \$500.

Provides that such authority shall be in addition to other present law authority granted to the board relative to tuition and fees.

Proposed law further authorizes the board to increase the amount of tuition charged per student at the lab school, for the 2012-2013 school year and thereafter, by an additional amount not to exceed \$500.
