Increases the number of authorized Tunica-Biloxi tribal officers eligible for supplemental pay

Proposed law increases from thirteen to twenty the number of tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana eligible for supplemental compensation to law enforcement personnel. Current law states that thirteen tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana shall be eligible for the state's supplemental payment of \$500 per month (\$6,000 annually) to qualified full-time police officers who have completed one year of service and who are employed full-time.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

The proposed law increases the number of Tunica-Biloxi Tribal officers eligible for supplemental pay from 13 to 20. The proposed law will require an additional \$42,000 in annual expenditures (\$500 per officer x 12 months x 7 additional supplemental pay recipients = \$42,000).

REVENUE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental revenues as a result of this measure.
