Provides relative to the collection, analysis and reburial of exposed human skeletal remains from municipal and abandoned cemeteries. (8/1/12)

Purpose of Bill: This bill 1) provides for the collection, analysis, and reburial of exposed human remains; 2) establishes the responsibilities of certain cemetery authorities, the Louisiana Cemetery Board, and the Attorney General for performing or arranging for such reburials; 3) authorizes assistance from institutes of higher learning; 4) establishes protocols for the identification, labeling, storage, and documentation required for collection activities, and 5) shields those assisting in such activities from certain legal liabilities.
