PRIVATE INVESTIGATORS: Changes membership of the La. State Board of Private Investigator Examiners

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:3504(B), relative to the Louisiana State Board of Private
3 Investigator Examiners; to provide for membership; and to provide for related
4 matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 37:3504(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §3504. Louisiana State Board of Private Investigator Examiners; creation;
8 qualifications; domicile; terms of office; confirmation; oath of office;
9 compensation

11 B. The board shall be composed of ~~seven~~ six members appointed by the
12 governor. One member shall be appointed from each of the five public service
13 commission districts as established by law and shall be a resident of the district from
14 which he is appointed. The governor shall appoint one licensed attorney to serve on
15 the board from the state at large ~~and one member from the state at large appointed~~
16 ~~from a list of names submitted by the board of directors of the Louisiana Private~~
17 ~~Investigators Association~~. Each member of the board shall be a citizen of the United
18 States of America, a resident of Louisiana, at least twenty-one years of age and,
19 except for the attorney appointed from the state at large, shall have been actively
20 engaged in the private investigator business for the previous five years, earning at
