Abstract: Reduces the membership of the La. State Board of Private Investigator Examiners by removing a member at large.

Present law creates the La. State Board of Private Investigator Examiners composed of seven members appointed by the governor as follows:

- (1) One from each of the five public service commission districts.
- (2) One attorney from the state at large.
- (3) One from the state at large appointed from a list of names submitted by the board of directors of the La. Private Investigators Association.

Proposed law reduces the membership of the board from seven to six by deleting the member from the state at large appointed from a list of names submitted by the La. Private Investigators Association.
