DIGEST

Present law provides that public officials and officers and public agencies, including but not limited to all law enforcement agencies, sheriffs, district attorneys, judicial officers, clerks of court, the Crime Victims Reparations Board, and the Dept. of Children and Family Services or any division thereof, cannot publicly disclose the name, address, or identity of juvenile victims of certain felony sex offenses.

Proposed law retains present law and adds that present law also applies to misdemeanor sex offenses when the victim is a juvenile.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
