COMMERCIAL REGULATIONS

EG SEE FISC NOTE RV See Note

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Provides relative to certain misleading solicitations by nongovernmental entities which imply certain state governmental connections

Proposed bill prohibits solicitations by a nongovernmental entity for a purchase of or payment for a product or service that have a misleading appearance of a Louisiana state government connection, approval or endorsement. Proposed legislation provides for violators of proposed bill shall be subject to a civil fine of not more than \$1,000 per violation. Proposed legislation provides for the attorney general to bring proceedings to recover all fines due pursuant to this bill.
