12 (c) The driver's license number; of a registered voter.

13 (d) The day and month of the date of birth; of a registered voter.

14 (e) The mother's maiden name; ~~or~~ of a registered voter.

15 (f) The electronic mail address of a registered voter; ~~or circulate the~~
16 fact that registered voters are entitled to assistance in voting or the social
17 security numbers, driver's license numbers, day and month of the dates of
18 birth, mother's maiden names, or electronic mail addresses of registered
19 voters on commercial lists, except when

20 (2)(a) The provisions of Paragraph (1) of this Subsection shall not
21 apply to voter registration data is transmitted to the office of motor vehicles
22 of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections, for the purposes of
23 verifying the accuracy and authenticity of the social security number, driver's
24 license number, or full date of birth provided by the voter. The office of
25 motor vehicles shall not disclose information concerning a registered voter
26 transmitted pursuant to this Subparagraph, except that it may transmit such
27 information to the United States Social Security Administration for the
28 purposes of verifying the accuracy and authenticity of the social security
29 number provided by the voter.

30 (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraph (1) of this
31 Subsection, the Department of State or registrar of voters may transmit the
32 full date of birth of a registered voter to the Supervisory Committee on
33 Campaign Finance Disclosure to verify the identity of a candidate for
34 purposes of campaign finance reporting. The supervisory committee shall
35 not disclose the full date of birth of a registered voter transmitted pursuant
36 to this Subparagraph.
