SENATE BILL NO. 304

BY SENATORS PETERSON, MORRELL, MURRAY, RISER AND TARVER

PUBLIC BUILDINGS/GROUNDS. Names the new UMC/LSU Hospital in New Orleans the "Reverend Avery C. Alexander Academic Research Hospital". (gov sig)

AN ACT

To enact R.S. 49:149.30, relative to the names of state buildings; to name the new University Medical Center/Louisiana State University Hospital in New Orleans the "Reverend Avery C. Alexander Academic Research Hospital"; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 49:149.30 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

§149.30. Reverend Avery C. Alexander Academic Research Hospital

The new University Medical Center/Louisiana State University Hospital currently under construction in the city of New Orleans is hereby named, and shall hereafter be known as, the Reverend Avery C. Alexander Academic Research Hospital.

Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become effective on the day following such approval.

Peterson (SB 304)
