## DIGEST

Proposed law establishes a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Republican Party of Louisiana" plate and a special prestige motor vehicle license plate to be known as the "Democratic Party of Louisiana" plate. These license plates shall be restricted to use on passenger cars, pickup trucks, recreational vehicles, and vans and the color and design of the license plate shall be selected by the organization.

Proposed law provides that the charge for the special license plate shall be the standard motor vehicle license tax imposed, plus an annual royalty fee of \$25 for each plate, and a handling fee of \$3.50 to be retained by the department to offset a portion of administrative costs.

Proposed law provides that an annual royalty fee shall be collected by the department and forwarded to the organization.

Proposed law provides that the first 500 plates shall be reserved for purchase at the direction of the organization.

Proposed law provides that the secretary shall establish a prestige plate for the organization in accordance with provisions of proposed law when the following conditions are met:

- (1) The executive committee for the organization has selected and approved a design for the license plate.
- (2) The secretary has received a minimum of 1,000 applications for the license plate.

Proposed law provides that the secretary may promulgate rules and regulations as are necessary to implement the provisions of proposed law.
