REVENUE DEPARTMENT: Authorizes the disclosure of certain taxpayer information to the La. Clerks' of Court Association

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 47:1508(B)(30), relative to the Department of Revenue; to authorize the  
3 disclosure of certain taxpayer information to the Louisiana Clerks' of Court  
4 Association; to restrict the use of such information; and to provide for related  
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 47:1508(B)(30) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1508. Confidential character of tax records

12 (30) The secretary from disclosing to the Louisiana Clerks' of Court  
13 Association information regarding a parish residents' name, address, and the last four  
14 digits of his social security number solely for the purpose of assisting the parish

**Abstract:** Authorizes the secretary to disclose the name, address, and last four digits of a parish resident's social security number to the La. Clerks' of Court Association for the purpose of assisting parish clerks of court in constructing jury rolls.

Present law provides for the confidentiality of taxpayer records and for exceptions under which information may be shared with other public entities.

Proposed law retains present law and adds an exception for the disclosure of the name, address, and last four digits of a parish resident's social security number solely for the purpose of assisting the parish clerks of court in constructing and maintaining jury rolls.
