4 On page 1, line 12, change "(B)(2)" to "(B)(2) and (3)"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 2, line 5, after "days" and before "subject" change "shall" to "may"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 3, at the end of line 18, add the following:

9 "However, if the claim involves the care of a pregnant mother and her unborn  
10 child, then naming the mother as the patient shall be sufficient."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 5

12 On page 4, between lines 9 and 10, insert the following:

13 "(3) Ninety days after the notification to all parties by certified mail by the  
14 attorney chairman ~~of~~ or the board of the dissolution of the medical review panel or  
15 ninety days after the expiration of any court-ordered extension as authorized by  
16 Paragraph (1) of this Subsection, the suspension of the running of prescription with  
17 respect to a qualified health care provider shall cease."
