DIGEST

Proposed law prohibits any person who intentionally follows another person to cause a reasonable person to feel alarmed, to suffer emotional distress, or to place the person in a reasonable apprehension of receiving a battery or other crime from claiming self-defense unless he withdraws from the conduct in good faith and in such a manner that the other person knows or should know that the aggressor desires to withdraw and discontinue the conduct, except when:

1. A peace officer is acting in the course and scope of his employment and performing his duties.
2. A private investigator or insurance investigator is acting in the course and scope of his employment and performing his duties and conducting an investigation.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
