HB No. 513

Abstract: Requires prospective apprentices in the Bail Bond Apprentice Program to register identifying information with the commissioner of insurance.

Present law provides for the creation of a Bail Bond Apprentice Program, whereby apprentices complete the registered insurance producer and bail producer precicensing program under the instruction of a supervising bail producer.

Proposed law requires the apprentice to register his name, home address, and telephone number, as well as his date of birth and social security number with the commissioner of insurance. Further requires the apprentice to disclose the date he will be entering the program and to give contact information for his supervising licensed bail bond producer. Otherwise retains present law.

Present law provides that the program consists of an apprentice's consecutive months of employment with a licensed bail bond producer.

Proposed law changes the duration of the program from six months to three.

Present law requires the supervising bail bond producer to maintain an apprentice's work hour records, including time sheets and pay stubs. Such records are to be available for examination and review by the Dept. of Insurance.

Proposed law retains present law but further requires that the work records include specifically the number of hours worked, the specific functions performed, and the date and time of the performance of those functions.
