Abstract: Provides for child care expenses incurred while a parent is obtaining job training or an education may be included in net child care costs for the purposes of child support determination.

Present law, relative to child support calculations, provides for child care expenses incurred by a parent due to the parent's employment or job searching.

Proposed law retains present law and adds that net child care costs may include reasonable child care expenses incurred while a parent is receiving job training or an education to obtain employment, provided the costs do not unreasonably burden the parent paying child support.
