SEX OFFENSE/REGISTRY

EG INCREASE LF RV See Note

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Provides relative to sex offender registration and notification

Proposed legislation requires sex offenders convicted or adjudicated under the laws of another state, or military, territorial, foreign, tribal, or federal law; procedures for Louisiana offenders with out-of-state activities to provide certified copies of court records pertaining to the offense or offenses which require registration as a sex offender to the bureau within three business days of establishing residence in Louisiana.

Proposed legislation amends present law and provides that for any person convicted under the laws of another state who moves to La. and is required to register under the laws of this state, shall do so for the length of time required by the jurisdiction of his conviction or the length of time required in La., whichever period is longer.

Proposed legislation provides that the frequency of in-person periodic renewals of registration for certain offenders shall be conducted pursuant to present law.

The exact revenue increase is indeterminable since it is unknown how many sex offenders convicted or adjudicated under the laws of another state, or military, territorial, foreign, tribal, or federal law will establish residence in Louisiana.
