REVENUE DEPARTMENT: Authorizes the disclosure of certain taxpayer information to the La. Clerks' of Court Association

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 47:1508(B)(30), relative to the Department of Revenue; to authorize the
3 disclosure of certain taxpayer information to the Louisiana Clerks' of Court
4 Association; to restrict the use of such information; and to provide for related
5 matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 47:1508(B)(30) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §1508. Confidential character of tax records

12 (30)(a) The secretary from annually disclosing, beginning September 1,
13 2012, to the Louisiana Clerks' of Court Association, a listing of each taxpayer who
14 filed a return for the previous calendar year, which shall include only the resident's
15 name, address, and the last four digits of the taxpayer's social security number. The
16 list shall be provided in an electronic format without cost to the Louisiana Clerks'
17 of Court Association.

18 (b) Upon written request of any district clerk of court, the Louisiana Clerks'
19 of Court Association shall provide to the clerk the electronic list for the respective
20 parish. The list provided by the secretary pursuant to the provisions of this
21 Paragraph shall not be considered a public record; however, the jury venire roll
22 constructed by the district clerk of court shall be considered a public record.

HB No. 1102

Abstract: Authorizes the secretary to annually disclose, beginning Sept. 1, 2012, the name, address, and last four digits of a taxpayer's social security number to the La. Clerks' of Court Association.

Present law provides for the confidentiality of taxpayer records and for exceptions under which information may be shared with other public entities.

Proposed law retains present law and adds an exception, beginning of Sept. 1, 2012, for the disclosure of a list which contains only the name, address, and last four digits of a taxpayer's social security number to the La. Clerk's of Court Association, hereinafter "association". Further provides for annual disclosure of the list, which shall be in an electronic format without cost to the association.

Proposed law requires that upon written request of any district clerk of court, the association shall provide to the clerk the electronic list for the respective parish. Further provides that the list shall not be considered a public record; however, the jury venire roll constructed by the district clerk of court shall be considered a public record.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on Ways and Means to the original bill.

1. Deleted provision specifying that the purpose of the list is to assist the parish clerks of court in constructing and maintaining jury rolls.
2. Added provision that annual disclosure of the list by the secretary shall begin Sept. 1, 2012, and that the list shall be provided in an electronic format without cost to the association.
3. Required the electronic parish list to be provided to the district clerk of court upon written request to the association.
4. Added provision that the list from the secretary shall not be considered a public record; however, the jury venire roll constructed by the district clerk of court shall be considered a public record.
