HB No. 586

Abstract: Increases the age of which a person must submit a signed statement attesting to supervised driving practice when issued a Class "E" driver's license for the first time.

Present law requires a 17 year old or older first time Class "E" license applicant to provide a signed statement to the department attesting that the applicant has completed a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving practice with a licensed parent, guardian, or adult of at least 21 years of age or older.

Proposed law increases the age at which a person must submit a signed statement to 18 years of age.
