
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to Original House Bill No. 365 by Representative Stuart Bishop

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 3, delete "prior to qualifying"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 8, change "who desires to become" to "who becomes"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 9, after "required" delete the comma "," and the remainder of the line and on
7 line 10, delete "filing his notice of candidacy for such an office."

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 1, delete lines 13 through 16 and insert the following:

10 "B. Each person who has qualified for a statewide elective office or the
11 office of state representative or state senator shall certify that he has obtained at least
12 one hour of ethics education and training as required by this Section by executing the
13 certification designed pursuant to Subsection C of this Section. The certification
14 shall be filed with the Board of Ethics no later than the deadline for filing a financial
15 disclosure statement filed pursuant to R.S. 18:1495.7."

16 AMENDMENT NO. 5

17 On page 1, line 18, delete "in conjunction with the secretary of state"

18 AMENDMENT NO. 6

19 On page 1, line 18, change "at minimum" to "at a minimum"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 7

21 On page 1, line 19, after "correct" delete the comma "," and delete the remainder of the line
22 and line 20 and insert a period "." and the following:

23 "D. The certification form and a notice to the candidate regarding the
24 requirements and the availability of education and training shall be included in the
25 informational packets provided for in R.S. 18:463(D)."
