Provides relative to sex offender registration and notification

Proposed legislation requires a person convicted under the laws of another state to provide certified copies of court records pertaining to the offense or offenses which require registration as a sex offender to the bureau within 30 business days of establishing residence in LA. Proposed legislation decreases the time period within which the bureau shall make its determination as to the time period of registration and the frequency of in-person periodic renewals to within 60 days of receiving the certified copies of court records from the offender. Proposed legislation provides that until the bureau makes this determination the offender shall appear for in-person renewals every 3 months and thereafter the frequency with which he is required to appear will be based upon the determination by the bureau. Proposed legislation provides that a person who is convicted under the laws of another state who is required to register as a sex offender pursuant to present law shall do so for the period of time required by his state of conviction or for the period of time required by LA, whichever period is longer.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

The proposed legislation would result in an indeterminable increase in local fund revenues. A sex offender must register with the sheriff of the parish he resides in and pay an annual fee of \$60. The exact revenue increase is indeterminable since it is unknown how many sex offenders convicted or adjudicated under the laws of another state, or military, territorial, foreign, tribal, or federal law will establish residence in Louisiana.
