

- 1 (3) The secretary of the Department of Veterans Affairs, or his designee.
- 2 (4) The secretary of the Department of Health and Hospitals, or his designee.
- 3 (5) The state senator for Senate District 13, or his designee.
- 4 (6) The state representative for House District 65, or his designee.
- 5 (7) The mayor of the city of Central, or his designee.
- 6 (8) The executive director of the Recreation and Park Commission for the parish of
- 7 East Baton Rouge.
- 8 (9) The chancellor of Baton Rouge Community College, or his designee.
- 9 (10) The chairman of the Capital Area Human Services District, or his designee.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the names of the members on the advisory group
11 shall be submitted to the secretary of the Department of Veterans Affairs no later than
12 September 1, 2012.

13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the advisory group shall convene its first
14 meeting no later than September 15, 2012.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the secretary of the Department of Veterans
16 Affairs shall designate the chairperson of the advisory group from the membership of the
17 advisory group.

18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the advisory group shall provide for the manner
19 and frequency of its meetings at its first meeting, and it shall be staffed by the Department
20 of Veterans Affairs.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the advisory group shall meet as necessary and
22 shall report its findings and recommendations to the legislature no later than February 1,
23 2013.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the advisory group shall terminate upon the date
25 of submission of its report or February 1, 2013, whichever occurs first.

26 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
27 office of the lieutenant governor, the office of the secretary of state, the office of the
28 secretary of the Department of Veterans Affairs, the office of the secretary of the
29 Department of Health and Hospitals, the office of the state senator for Senate District 13, the
30 office of the state representative for House District 65, the office of the mayor of the city of
