SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 93

BY SENATOR PERRY

CRIMINAL JUSTICE. Requests the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board to meet and facilitate in the development of an integrated criminal justice information system.

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

To urge and request the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System (ICJIS) Policy Board to meet and coordinate the integration of the various criminal justice automated information systems.

WHEREAS, the state of Louisiana and citizens thereof have a vital interest in accurate data concerning the operations of the Louisiana criminal justice system and its component agencies; and

WHEREAS, such interests include, but are not limited to accurate data concerning DWI offenses, sex crimes and crimes of violence; and

WHEREAS, arrest, charging, disposition and other critical information for these and other offenses is housed in hundreds of criminal justice agencies across the state; and

WHEREAS, in most instances, such data is contained in automated information systems designed to assist these criminal justice agencies; and

WHEREAS, state police, sheriffs, district attorneys and district courts have developed and implemented management information systems for their constituent agencies; and

WHEREAS, the most efficient and accurate method of gathering accurate data on criminal justice system operations is through the utilization of such automated information

2 WHEREAS, the integration of these systems will facilitate communication and  
3 information sharing between all criminal justice agencies in Louisiana; and

4 WHEREAS, the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board was  
5 created by Act No. 864 of the 1999 Regular Session of the Legislature, with the purpose of  
6 assisting the agencies involved in the operations of the individual systems by facilitating the  
7 development of an ICJIS, providing for common standards which ensure communications  
8 among systems, and providing a common forum for the discussion of issues affecting the  
9 agencies involved; and

10 WHEREAS, the membership of the ICJIS Board includes the following:

- 11 (1) The secretary of the Department of Public Safety and Corrections or his designee.  
12 (2) The deputy secretary for public safety services or his designee.  
13 (3) One member designated by the Louisiana Association of Chiefs of Police.  
14 (4) One member designated by the Louisiana Sheriff's Association.  
15 (5) One member designated by the Louisiana District Attorneys' Association.  
16 (6) One member designated by the Louisiana District Court Judges Association.  
17 (7) One member designated by the Louisiana Association of Clerks of Court.  
18 (8) The chief justice of the Supreme Court of Louisiana or his representative.  
19 (9) The attorney general of Louisiana or his designee.  
20 (10) The executive director of the Louisiana Commission on Law Enforcement and  
21 Administration of Criminal Justice.  
22 (11) A member of the Senate designated by the president of the Senate.  
23 (12) A member of the House of Representatives designated by the speaker of the  
24 House of Representatives.  
25 (13) One member designated by the governor.  
26 (14) The deputy secretary of youth services of the Department of Public Safety and  
27 Corrections or his designee.

28 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby  
29 direct the Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board to meet and  
30 coordinate the integration of the various criminal justice automated information systems and

1 to report its progress to the legislature during the 2013 Regular Session of the Legislature.  
2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the  
3 Integrated Criminal Justice Information System Policy Board.
