HOUSE BILL NO. 510

BY REPRESENTATIVES BURFORD AND COX

JUDGES/JUSTICE OF PEACE: Provides for the territorial jurisdiction and election districts of the justice of the peace courts and constables in DeSoto Parish

1 AN ACT

2 To enact R.S. 13:2621, relative to the DeSoto Parish justice of the peace courts; to provide
3 for the territorial jurisdiction of such courts; to provide relative to the election to the
4 offices of justice of the peace and constable; to provide for effective dates; and to
5 provide for related matters.

6 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

7 Section 1. R.S. 13:2621 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

8 §2621. Territorial jurisdiction; DeSoto Parish justice of the peace courts

9 A. The territorial limits of the justice of the peace courts in DeSoto Parish
10 shall be as follows:

11 (1) The first justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts
12 11, 15, 28, 31, 32, 34, 35, and 37.

13 (2) The second justice of the peace district and court shall consist of
14 Precincts 3, 16, 23, and 30.

15 (3) The third justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts
16 27, 42, 44, 46, 48, 50, 53, 55, 57, and 59.

17 (4) The fourth justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts
18 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 20, 52, 60, and 63.

19 (5) The fifth justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts
20 9, 21, 22, 26, 33, 38, 39, 41, and 56.

1 (6) The sixth justice of the peace district and court shall consist of Precincts

2 10, 12, 19, 29, 36, 47, 49, 51, 58, and 61.

3 B. The districts provided in Subsection A of this Section shall be effective

4 for election purposes with the opening of the qualifying period for the regularly

5 scheduled 2014 primary election for justices of the peace and constables, and the

6 persons elected to the offices of justice of the peace and constable for such justice

7 of the peace courts in DeSoto Parish at the next regularly scheduled election and

8 their successors shall be elected from the districts provided in Subsection A of this

9 Section. The provisions of Subsection A of this Section shall be effective for all

10 other purposes beginning January 1, 2015.

11 Section 2.(A) The precincts referenced in this Act are those Voting Districts (VTDs)

12 contained in the 2010 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the Parish of DeSoto

13 in the State of Louisiana.

14 (B) When a precinct referenced in this Act has been subdivided by action of the

15 parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish

16 governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with the provisions of R.S.

17 18:532.1, the enumeration in this Act of the general precinct designation shall include all

18 nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof, however such subdivisions may be

19 designated. The territorial limits of the districts as provided in this Act shall continue in

20 effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish

21 governing authority.

22 Section 3. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not

23 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature

24 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If

25 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become

26 effective on the day following such approval.

Abstract: Redistricts the justice of the peace courts and constable districts in DeSoto Parish.

Presently there are six justice of the peace courts in DeSoto Parish. Each elects a justice of the peace and a constable.

Proposed law changes the territorial jurisdiction of the six justice of the peace courts in DeSoto Parish and therefore the election districts for justice of the peace and constable. (See attached map and statistics.)

Proposed law provides that the districts provided in proposed law shall be effective for election purposes with the opening of the qualifying period for the 2014 primary election for justice of the peace and constables and that the persons elected to the offices of justice of the peace and constable for such justice of the peace courts at the next regularly scheduled election and their successors shall be elected from the districts provided in proposed law. Proposed law provides that the districts provided in proposed law shall be effective for all other purposes on Jan. 1, 2015.

Proposed law specifies that precincts referenced in district descriptions are those precincts identified as Voting Districts (VTDs) in the 2010 Census Redistricting TIGER/Line Shapefiles for the parish of DeSoto, state of La. Also specifies that if any such precinct has been subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a nongeographic basis or subdivided by action of the parish governing authority on a geographic basis in accordance with present law, the enumeration of the general precinct designation shall include all nongeographic and all geographic subdivisions thereof. Further provides that the territorial limits of the districts as enacted shall continue in effect without change regardless of any changes made to the precincts by the parish governing authority.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.

Population data in the summaries accompanying this digest are derived from 2010 Census Redistricting Data (Public Law 94-171), Summary File for La. Population data, statistical information, and maps are supplied for purposes of information and analysis and comprise no part of proposed law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House


Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to the original bill.

1. Provides for the specific precincts in DeSoto Parish placed within each justice of the peace and constable district.

House Floor Amendments to the engrossed bill.

1. Provides that the districts are effective for election purposes beginning with the opening of qualifying for the 2014 primary election rather than the 2012 primary election, and for all purposes beginning Jan. 2015 rather than Jan. 2013.
