DIGEST

Buffington (SB 628)

Proposed law provides that the Department of Health and Hospitals shall have a moratorium on the licensure of level 4 adult residential care providers until July 1, 2017.

Proposed law provides the moratorium shall not apply to a provider which has received facility need review approval from the Department of Health and Hospitals for a level 4 adult residential care provider on or before April 25, 2012.

Effective August 1, 2011.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Health and Welfare to the original bill

1. Provides for DHH to implement a moratorium on the licensure of level 4 adult residential care providers until July 1, 2017.
2. Removes the provision requiring level 4 setting for medication administration for adult residential care.
3. Removes the provision requiring level 4 adult residential care providers to be certified for Medicaid participation and possess facility need review approval from DHH.
