

(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)

MTR VEHICLE/DRIVER LIC. Increases the age by which a person must submit a signed statement attesting to supervised driving practice when issued a Class "E" driver's license for the first time.

DIGEST

Present law requires a 17 year old or older first time Class "E" license applicant to provide a signed statement to the department attesting that the applicant has completed a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving practice with a licensed parent, guardian, or adult of at least 21 years of age or older.

Proposed law requires the parent or guardian of a seventeen year old, an emancipated seventeen year old, or an eighteen year old or older first time applicant for a Class "E" driver's license to submit a signed statement to attest to completion of a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving practice with a licensed parent, guardian, or adult of at least 21 years of age or older.

Proposed law corrects name of federal law to "Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986".

Effective August 1, 2012.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the reengrossed bill

1. Requires the parent or guardian of a seventeen year old, an emancipated seventeen year old, or an eighteen year old or older first time applicant for a Class "E" driver's license to submit a signed statement to attest to completion of a minimum of 50 hours of supervised driving practice with a licensed parent, guardian, or adult of at least 21 years of age or older.
2. Corrects name of federal law reference to "Commercial Motor Vehicle Safety Act of 1986".
