

HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Original House Bill No. 812 by Representative Champagne

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, line 3, after "state" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line 4, delete "to" and insert "from violations of federal and state environmental and water quality laws associated with"

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, line 15, after "by the state" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 16 and 17 and insert the following:

"for violations pursuant to section 311 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act, 33 U.S.C. 1321; R.S. 30:2025(E)(1) and (2); and R.S. 30:2001 et seq., including R.S. 30:2071 et seq., associated with the Deepwater Horizon oil spill that began on April 20, 2010, shall be deposited and credited by the treasurer to the Coastal Protection and Restoration Fund for integrated coastal protection efforts, including coastal restoration, hurricane protection, and improving the resiliency of the Louisiana Coastal Area affected by the Deepwater Horizon oil spill.

(2) Nothing in this Paragraph shall be construed as to affect funds associated with the Natural Resources Damage Assessment process."

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, at the beginning of line 1, change "(2)" to "(3)"

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 2, delete line 12, and insert the following:

"violations of federal and state environmental and water quality laws associated with the Deepwater Horizon oil spill that began on April"

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 2, line 13, after Fund and before the question mark "?" insert "for integrated coastal protection efforts"
