1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 14, between lines 6 and 7, insert the following:

3 **"01-102 OFFICE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL**

4 **EXPENDITURES:**

5 Administrative - Authorized Positions (16) \$ 1,707,225

6 **Program Description:** *The Office of State Inspector General's mission as a*
 7 *statutorily empowered law enforcement agency is to investigate, detect, and prevent*
 8 *fraud, corruption, waste, inefficiencies, mismanagement, misconduct, and abuse in*
 9 *the executive branch of state government. The office's mission promotes a high*
 10 *level of integrity, efficiency, effectiveness, and economy in the operations of state*
 11 *government, increasing the general public's confidence and trust in state*
 12 *government.*

13 **Objective:** The Office of State Inspector General (OIG) will investigate, detect, and
 14 prevent fraud, waste, corruption, misconduct, abuse, inefficiencies, and
 15 mismanagement in the Executive Branch of state government, including
 16 contractors, grantees, and subcontractors. In addition, the OIG will, within 30 days,
 17 document the receipt of complaints and how it intends to proceed. The dollar
 18 amount will meet or exceed the OIG annual general fund budget.

19 **Performance Indicators:**

20 Percentage of dollars identified as fraud and waste compared to the
 21 OIG general fund budget 100%
 22 Percentage of complaints with a final disposition determined within
 23 30 days of receipt 90%

24 **TOTAL EXPENDITURES** \$ 1,707,225

25 **MEANS OF FINANCE:**

26 State General Fund (Direct) \$ 1,701,895

27 Federal Funds \$ 5,330

28 **TOTAL MEANS OF FINANCING** \$ 1,707,225

29 Provided, however, that the commissioner of administration is hereby authorized and
 30 directed to adjust the means of finance for the Administrative Program by reducing the
 31 appropriation out of the State General Fund (Direct) by \$200,000.

32 Payable out of the State General Fund (Direct)
 33 to the Administrative Program for a statewide
 34 retirement adjustment \$ 100,740"
