DIGEST

Riser (SB 224)

Proposed law provides that beginning July 1, 2013, the office of motor vehicles of the DPSC shall provide a method for an applicant for a driver's license to include a special endorsement code to indicate whether applicant has been issued a lifetime hunting or fishing license pursuant to R.S. 56:649.1 et seq., a certificate of completion of firearm and hunter education pursuant to R.S. 56:699.5, and a certificate of completion of boating safety education issued pursuant to R.S. 34:851.36.

Proposed law provides inclusion of such special endorsement codes are solely at the option of the applicant for a driver's license.

Proposed law provides that possession of a driver's license which includes such special endorsement code satisfies any requirement to possess and exhibit such licenses or certificates.

Effective August 1, 2012.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Transportation, Highways, and Public Works to the original bill

1. Requires OMV beginning July 1, 2013, to provide a method for an applicant for driver's license to include a special endorsement code on a driver's license to indicate whether applicant has been issued a lifetime hunting or fishing license pursuant to R.S. 56:649.1, a certificate of completion of firearm and hunter safety education pursuant to R.S. 56:699.5, or a certificate of completion of boating safety education issued pursuant to R.S. 34:851.36.
2. Provides that inclusion of such special endorsement codes are solely at the option of the applicant for a driver's license.
3. Provides that possession of a driver's license which includes such special endorsement code satisfies any requirement to possess and exhibit such licenses or certificates.
