



1 known as "La Cote des Allemands" or "The German Coast"; and

2 WHEREAS, the combination of these parishes to form the River Region Caucus  
3 of Louisiana will bring together key components of the remarkable mix of history that make  
4 up one of the state's unique cultural milieu; and

5 WHEREAS, Louisiana would not be Louisiana without the traditions of each parish;  
6 and

7 WHEREAS, recognizing the significant role of Louisianians in these parishes will  
8 form a diverse caucus and it is appropriate that the Louisiana Senate and the Louisiana  
9 House of Representatives establish the River Region Caucus of Louisiana.

10 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Louisiana Senate and the Louisiana  
11 House of Representatives of the Legislature establish a River Region Caucus of Louisiana  
12 and the purpose of the caucus will be to represent and speak for Louisianians in the  
13 respective parishes and to preserve and enhance the traditions of citizens in Louisiana's  
14 political arena.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the River Region Caucus of Louisiana will  
16 include all members of the Louisiana Senate and Louisiana House of Representatives  
17 representing the Senatorial districts two, seventeen, eighteen, and nineteen, and the House  
18 districts of eighteen, fifty-one, fifty-six, fifty-seven, fifty-eight, fifty-nine, sixty, eighty-one,  
19 eighty-eight, and ninety-two.

20 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the officers of the caucus shall be selected at  
21 commencement of the first meeting.

22 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that appropriate official caucus symbols shall  
23 demonstrate the ties of the caucus, and its members and shall include the official Louisiana  
24 motto of union, justice and confidence.
