
SENATE FLOOR AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senator Martiny to Reengrossed House Bill No. 923 by Representative Ponti

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete Senate Committee Amendment No. 2 proposed by the Senate Committee on
3 Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs and adopted by the Senate on
4 May 3, 2012.

5 AMENDMENT NO. 2

6 On page 1, line 3, after "and (C)" insert ", to enact R.S. 37:3556.1,"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 18, between lines 2 and 3, insert:

9 "Section 2. R.S. 37:3556.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:

10 §3556.1. Course of study; hours

11 A. Pursuant to the licensure requirements provided in R.S. 37:3556, a course
12 of study may utilize a credit hours equivalent as defined by the United States
13 Department of Education in lieu of clock hours to measure student achievement. A
14 course of study using credit hours shall provide course work consistent with the rules
15 promulgated by the board including at least five hundred hours of in-class supervised
16 instruction.

17 B. The provisions of this Section shall terminate on January 1, 2013."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 4

19 On page 18, line 3, change "Section 2." to "Section 3."

20 AMENDMENT NO. 5

21 On page 18, after line 3, insert:

22 "Section 4. The provisions of Sections 1 and 3 of this Act shall become effective on
23 January 1, 2013.

24 Section 5. The provisions of Section 2 of this Act shall become effective upon
25 signature by the governor or, if not signed by the governor, upon expiration of the
26 time for bills to become law without signature by the governor, as provided by
27 Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If vetoed by the governor and
28 subsequently approved by the legislature, this Section 2 of this Act shall become
29 effective on the day following such approval."
