

**HOUSE SUMMARY OF SENATE AMENDMENTS**

House Bill No. 1082 by Representative Thibaut

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE PERMT: Provides relative to the required number and location of public restrooms in Class A-General retail establishments

**Synopsis of Senate Amendments**

1. Adds provisions to prohibit the issuance of a local or state Class "R" restaurant permit to any establishment that provides for live entertainment where breasts or buttocks are exposed.
2. Provides for technical amendments.

**Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Present law requires the commissioner to promulgate rules regarding requirements related to the number and location of public restrooms to be used in conjunction with the licensed premises of each Class A-General retail permit for low and high alcoholic beverages.

Proposed law requires the Class A-General retail establishment for low and high alcoholic beverage permits to comply with the requirements of DHH regarding the number and location of public restrooms and to provide proof of compliance from the office of public health.

Proposed law prohibits the issuance of a local or state Class "R" restaurant permit to any establishment that provides the type of entertainment described in present law, which requires entertainers whose breasts or buttocks are exposed to view to perform upon a certain type of stage.
