

**HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS**

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to Engrossed Senate Bill No. 363 by Senator Martiny

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "To" delete the remainder of the line and delete line 3 in its entirety  
 3 and insert "amend and reenact R.S. 27:319(B)(1)(a)(ii) and (b)(iii), relative to penalties for  
 4 certain violations of the Video Draw Poker Devices Control Law; to provide with respect  
 5 to the revocation of a license for certain violations; and to provide"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, line 6, after "Section 1." delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 7  
 8 through 15 in their entirety and insert the following:

9 "R.S. 27:319(B)(1)(a)(ii) and (b)(iii) are hereby amended and reenacted to read as  
 10 follows:

11 §319. Allowing underage persons to play video draw poker devices; penalties;  
 12 revocation of license

13 \* \* \*

14 B.(1) Violations of Subsection A of this Section shall be penalized by the  
 15 division as follows:

16 (a) For allowing a person under the age of twenty-one to play or operate a  
 17 video draw poker device at a licensed establishment, unless the licensee, his  
 18 employee, or agent reasonably believed that the person was twenty-one years old or  
 19 older:

21 (ii) For a third or subsequent violation, license revocation ~~shall~~ may be  
 22 imposed.

23 (b) For allowing a person under the age of twenty-one to play or operate a  
 24 video draw poker device at a licensed establishment when the licensee, his employee,  
 25 or agent is shown to have known or reasonably believed he was allowing a person  
 26 under the age of twenty-one years old to play or operate a video draw poker device,  
 27 or for allowing a person under the age fifteen years old to play or operate a video  
 28 draw poker device at a licensed establishment regardless of what the licensee, his  
 29 employee or agent knew or reasonably believed about the age of that person:

31 (iii) For a third or subsequent violation, license revocation ~~shall~~ may be  
 32 imposed."

33 AMENDMENT NO. 3

34 On page 1, after line 16, add the following:

35 "Section 2. In the event Senate Bill 575 of the 2012 Regular Session is enacted into  
 36 law, the Louisiana State Law Institute is hereby directed to redesignate R.S. 27:319 as  
 37 amended in this Act as R.S. 27:443."
