
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to Reengrossed House Bill No. 1207 by Representative Harrison

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "practices;" delete the remainder of the line and delete lines 3 and
3 4 and insert "to provide for certain contracts governing television services; to provide for
4 exceptions; to provide certain terms, conditions, and requirements; and to provide for related
5 matters."

6 AMENDMENT NO. 2

7 On page 1, line 7, delete "misrepresentation; local"

8 AMENDMENT NO. 3

9 On page 1, delete lines 9 through 14 and insert:

10 "A. The initial contract between a consumer and any person offering for sale
11 television services in this state shall specify each television station that shall be
12 accessible for viewing by the consumer under such contract. The failure to specify
13 each television station shall be an unfair and deceptive trade practice and shall be
14 governed by R.S. 51:1401 et seq."

16 On page 1, delete lines 17 through 19 and on page 2 delete lines 1 through 4
