
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection and International Affairs to Reengrossed House Bill No. 1188 by Representative Anders

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, change "1975" to "1976"

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 1, line 12, after "sellers;" insert "to provide for form of payments;"

5 AMENDMENT NO. 3

6 On page 1, line 18, after "penalties;" insert "to provide for preemption;"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 4

8 On page 2, line 4, change "1975" to "1976"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 5

10 On page 3, delete lines 5 and 6 and insert:

11 "C.(1) No secondhand dealer shall allow a seller to engage in multiple transactions
12 within a twenty-four hour period totaling more than three hundred dollars for the
13 purpose of circumventing this Section."

14 AMENDMENT NO. 6

15 On page 5, line 9, delete "of materials to be recycled or reused" and insert "of materials to
16 be recycled or reused"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 7

18 On page 8, line 24, delete "appropriate" and on line 25, after "entity" insert "owning the
19 materials and"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 8

21 On page 11, between lines 12 and 13 insert the following:

22 "C. Except for copper purchases, in lieu of a check, an operator may make payment
23 to the seller in the form of a loadable payment card. The operator shall require
24 verification of the seller's identification by a driver's license or similar means, and
25 shall require verification of the seller's address by a current utility bill. The operator
26 shall retain a copy of such utility bill."

27 AMENDMENT NO. 9

28 On page 11, delete lines 13 and 14 and insert the following:

29 "D.(1) No operator shall allow a seller to engage in multiple transactions within a
30 twenty-four hour period totaling more than three hundred dollars for the purpose of
31 circumventing this Section."

1 AMENDMENT NO. 10

2 On page 11, line 19, change "D." to "E."

3 AMENDMENT NO. 11

4 On page 12, between lines 20 and 21 and insert:

5 "§1976. Preemption

6 No governing authority of a political subdivision shall enact an ordinance in conflict

7 with the provisions of this Chapter."
