

**(KEYWORD, SUMMARY, AND DIGEST as amended by Senate committee amendments)**

**MOTOR VEHICLES: Specifies with regard to membership on the La. Motor Vehicle Commission.**

DIGEST

Present law provides for 18 members of the La. Motor Vehicle Commission, 14 appointed such that at least one, but no more than two, be from eight commission districts providing for geographic representation throughout the state. Requires, from these 14 members, one member to be primarily engaged in the business of lease or rental, one member primarily engaged in the business of sales finance, one member to be primarily engaged in the business of heavy truck sales, and three members to be primarily engaged in the business of recreational products. Provides that the remaining three members be from the public from the state at large and not licensees under the La. Motor Vehicle Commission.

Proposed law requires only one member be appointed from each of the eight commission districts, instead of allowing two from each district.

Proposed law changes the membership of the commission from three members primarily engaged in the business of recreational products to one member primarily engaged in the business of marine product sales, one member primarily engaged in the business of motorcycle sales, one member primarily engaged in the business of recreational vehicle sales.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Commerce, Consumer Protection, and International Affairs to the engrossed bill

1. Changes the three members of the commission from being primarily engaged in the business of recreational products to one member primarily engaged in the business of marine product sales, one member primarily engaged in the business of motorcycle sales, one member primarily engaged in the business of recreational vehicle sales.
