SUBJECT: House Rule 7.19, HB 1059 Engrossed (Supplemental Appropriations Bill)

Per House Rule 7.19, the Legislative Fiscal Office is required to submit a report to the House of Representatives, which indicates whether the appropriation bills appropriate one-time money. HB 1059 Engrossed includes a means of financing substitution that increases SGF in the amount of \$154,775,489 from various sources transferred within HB 822 Engrossed and decreases LA Medical Assistance Trust Fund (MATF) in a like amount. This is a technical means of finance substitution that provides no additional resources to support the FY 12 budget. Thus, the Legislative Fiscal Office has determined there is no one-time money in HB 1059 Engrossed supporting the FY 12 budget. These funds support the FY 13 budget, which have been accounted for in the Legislative Fiscal Office memo concerning the use of one-time money in HB 1 for FY 13.
