
HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to Original House Bill No. 370
by Representative Hoffmann

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 4, after "who" and before "controlled" delete "are abusing or addicted to
3 alcohol or" and insert "test positive while under arrest for"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 9, after "§1094." delete the remainder of the line and insert "Use of
6 controlled dangerous substances while pregnant; multidisciplinary team"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 3

8 On page 1, after line 12, after "woman" delete the remainder of the line and insert "under
9 arrest tests positive for controlled dangerous substances, as provided for in the Uniform
10 Controlled Dangerous Substances Law."

11 AMENDMENT NO. 4

12 On page 1, delete line 13 in its entirety

13 AMENDMENT NO. 5

14 On page 1, line 14, after "team" delete the remainder of the line and line 15 in its entirety
15 and insert the following:

- 16 "may include but is not limited to the following persons:
17 (1) A Louisiana board certified physician trained in obstetrics and
18 gynecology.
19 (2) A licensed nurse with experience in caring for drug- or alcohol-exposed
20 newborn infants.
21 (3) A law enforcement officer employed by a local or state law enforcement
22 agency.
23 (4) An employee of the Department of Children and Family Services with
24 a background and experience with federal and state benefits, such as Medicaid.
25 (5) An individual associated with a nonprofit organization with a background
26 and experience in charitable and faith-based resources for treatment of alcohol and
27 drug abuse or addiction.
28 (6) A licensed social worker or counselor with training and experience in the
29 treatment of drug or alcohol addiction."

30 AMENDMENT NO. 6

31 On page 1, after line 19, add "D. The authority provided by the provisions of this Section
32 shall exist from the time of arrest to the time of dismissal, acquittal, or conviction."
