
SENATE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to Engrossed House Bill No. 1117 by Representative Billiot

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, after "R.S." delete the remainder of the line and delete line 3 in its entirety
3 and on line 4, delete "and court costs in certain circumstances" and insert the following:

4 "33:4718, relative to the authority of parish governing authorities, to provide for the
5 dedication of property for certain purposes; to provide for the revocation of certain
6 dedications; to provide for exchanges to certain dedicated property"

7 AMENDMENT NO. 2

8 On page 1, line 6, after "R.S." change "33:1236(21)(a)(i)" to "33:4718"

9 AMENDMENT NO. 3

10 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 20 and on page 2, delete lines 1 through 19 and insert the
11 following:

12 "§4718. Revocation of dedication of parks, public squares or plots, reversion of
13 property

14 The parish governing authorities and municipal corporations of the state,
15 except the parish of Orleans, may revoke and set aside the dedication of all parks,
16 public squares or plots dedicated to public use within their respective limits, when
17 such parks, public squares or plots have been abandoned or are no longer needed for
18 public purposes.

19 Upon such revocation, the title to the land covered by and embraced in said
20 parks, public squares or plots, shall revert to the person or persons who were the
21 owners of such land at the time of the dedication, their heirs, successors or assigns.
22 The reversion provided for in this Section shall not apply when a parish governing
23 authority exchanges property dedicated to public use for property of equal or greater
24 value to be dedicated for the same such public purpose or use."
