AN ACT

To amend and reenact R.S. 14:95.2.2(D), relative to reckless discharge of a firearm at a
parade; to increase penalties; and to provide for related matters.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

Section 1. R.S. 14:95.2.2(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

§95.2.2. Reckless discharge of a firearm at a parade or demonstration

* * *

D. Whoever commits the crime of reckless or negligent discharge of a
firearm at a parade or demonstration shall be sentenced to imprisonment at hard
labor for not less than five nor more than ~~ten~~ fifteen years, at least three years of the
sentence imposed shall be served without benefit of parole, probation, or suspension
of sentence and shall be fined not more than five thousand dollars.
