1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact Code of Civil Procedure Article 2293(B)(1), relative to notice of  
3 seizure in judgment debtor cases; to provide for the form of such notice; and to  
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. Code of Civil Procedure Article 2293(B)(1) is hereby amended and  
7 reenacted to read as follows:

8 Art. 2293. Notice to judgment debtor; appointment of attorney

10 B.(1) After the seizure of property, the sheriff shall serve promptly upon the  
11 judgment debtor a written notice of the seizure and a list of the property seized, in  
12 the manner provided for service of citation. If service cannot be made on the  
13 judgment debtor or his attorney of record, the court shall appoint an attorney upon  
14 whom service may be made. The notice of seizure shall be substantially similar to  
15 the form provided in R.S. 13:3852.
