DIGEST

Present law provides that only a person having a real and actual interest can bring an action.

Proposed law retains present law and provides that a corporation, limited liability company, or other juridical entity can have a real and actual interest in what it asserts when doing so for the benefit of its members.

(Amends C.C.P. Art. 681)

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to the engrossed bill

1. Deleted the ability for an unincorporated association to maintain a real and actual interest in an action brought on behalf of any of its members.
