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Provides relative to registration and regulation of Professional Employer Organizations by the Dept. of Insurance and the La. Workforce Commision

Current law authorizes the Department of Insurance and the Workforce Commission to register and regulate Professional Employer Organizations (PEOs). According to the statutory definition, a PEO is any person that offers professional employer services pursuant to a professional employer services agreement with a client, including but not limited to administrative services organizations and employee leasing organizations that provide services pursuant to a PEO agreement.

Proposed law allows the Department of Insurance and Workforce Commission to accept all filings of regulatory and/or registration documents electronically.
