Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Finance to Reengrossed House Bill No. 822 by Representative Fannin

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 2, delete "22:842," and insert "22:842, R.S. 24:39, and R.S. 47:302.2(B),  
3 332.4(B), 332.6(B), 332.18(B), and 332.19(B) and to enact R.S. 47:302.2(D),"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 3, after "Fund;" and before "to provide", insert "to provide for the allowable  
6 use of monies in the Legislative Capitol Technology Enhancement Fund; to provide for the  
7 use of monies in the Shreveport Riverfront and Convention Center and Independence  
8 Stadium Fund, the St. John the Baptist Convention Facility Fund, the Iberville Parish Visitor  
9 Enterprise Fund, and the West Baton Rouge Parish Visitor Enterprise Fund;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 2, between line 5 and 6, insert the following:

12 "Section 2. R.S. 24:39 is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

13 §39. Legislative Capitol Technology Enhancement Fund

15 D. Monies in the fund shall be available for appropriation to and use by the  
16 Legislative Budgetary Control Council, hereinafter referred to as the "council". Such  
17 appropriations shall be used by the council solely to fund construction,  
18 improvements, maintenance, renovations, repairs, and necessary additions to the  
19 House chamber, Senate chamber, legislative committee meeting rooms, and other  
20 legislative rooms, offices, and areas in the Capitol Complex for audio-visual  
21 upgrades and technology enhancements and for supporting all other operations and  
22 activities consistent with the authorized mission of the council.

24 Section 3. R.S. 47:302.2(B), 332.4(B), 332.6(B), 332.18(B), and 332.19(B) are  
25 hereby amended and reenacted and R.S. 47:302.2(D) is hereby enacted to read as follows:

26 §302.2. Disposition of certain collections in the city of Shreveport

27 \* \* \*

28 B. The monies in the Shreveport Riverfront and Convention Center and  
29 Independence Stadium Fund shall be subject to annual appropriation by the  
30 legislature. Except as provided in Subsection (D) of this Section, the ~~The~~ monies in  
31 the fund shall be available exclusively for the purposes provided in Subsection C of  
32 this Section. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund shall remain in  
33 the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the treasurer in the same  
34 manner as the monies in the state general fund, and all interest earned shall be  
35 deposited into the state general fund.

37 D. Notwithstanding any other provision of this Section to the contrary, for the  
38 2012-2013 Fiscal Year monies in the fund may be made available for the LSU  
39 Health Sciences Center Shreveport provided, however, that any distributions of  
40 monies to the LSU Health Sciences Center Shreveport shall occur in equal quarterly  
41 amounts after the distributions to entities which have pledged or dedicated such  
42 monies into bonds have been made each quarter.

44 §332.4. Disposition of certain collections in St. John the Baptist Parish

46 B. The monies in the St. John the Baptist Convention Facility Fund shall be  
47 subject to an annual appropriation by the legislature. The monies in the fund shall  
48 be available exclusively for economic development and tourism purposes, for

1 acquisition of land, and for acquisition and/or construction of buildings for use as the  
2 St. John the Baptist Convention Facility. All unexpended and unencumbered monies  
3 in the fund shall remain in the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the  
4 treasurer in the same manner as the monies in the state general fund, and all interest  
5 earned shall be deposited in the state general fund.

7 §332.6. Disposition of certain collections in the city of Shreveport

8 \* \* \*

9 B. The monies in the Shreveport Riverfront and Convention Center and  
10 Independence Stadium Fund shall be subject to an annual appropriation by the  
11 legislature. The monies in the fund shall be available exclusively for the purposes  
12 provided in R.S. 47:302.2(C) and (D). However, forty thousand dollars of the  
13 monies deposited in the fund shall be allocated annually to Pamoja Art Society for  
14 African-American cultural activities in Shreveport, fifty thousand dollars of the  
15 monies deposited into the fund shall be allocated annually to the Shreveport  
16 Multicultural Center, Inc., and ten thousand dollars of the monies deposited in the  
17 fund shall be allocated annually to the Rho Omega and Friends, Inc. for the Good  
18 Time Rho Festival. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund shall  
19 remain in the fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the treasurer in the  
20 same manner as the monies in the state general fund, and all interest earned shall be  
21 deposited in the state general fund.

23 §332.18. Disposition of certain collections in Iberville Parish

25 B. The monies in the Iberville Parish Visitor Enterprise Fund shall be subject  
26 to an annual appropriation by the legislature to the parish governing authority of  
27 Iberville Parish. The monies in the fund shall be made available exclusively for  
28 economic development and tourism purposes, planning, development, or capital  
29 improvements of tourism sites in the parish of Iberville. All unexpended and  
30 unencumbered monies in the fund shall remain in the fund. The monies in the fund  
31 shall be invested by the treasurer in the same manner as the monies in the state  
32 general fund, and all interest earned shall be deposited in the state general fund.

34 §332.19. Disposition of certain collections in West Baton Rouge Parish

35 \* \* \*

36 B. The monies in the West Baton Rouge Parish Visitor Enterprise Fund shall  
37 be subject to an annual appropriation by the legislature to the parish governing  
38 authority of West Baton Rouge Parish. The monies in the fund shall be made  
39 available exclusively for economic development and tourism purposes, planning,  
40 development, or capital improvements of tourism sites in the parish of West Baton  
41 Rouge. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund shall remain in the  
42 fund. The monies in the fund shall be invested by the treasurer in the same manner  
43 as the monies in the state general fund, and all interest earned shall be deposited in  
44 the state general fund.

47 Section 4. The Budget Stabilization Replenishment Fund, hereafter referred to as the  
48 fund, is hereby created in the state treasury. After complying with the provisions of Article  
49 VII, Section 9(B) of the Constitution of Louisiana relative to the allocation of monies to the  
50 Bond Security and Redemption Fund, the treasurer shall make the deposits required by this  
51 Subsection. The treasurer shall deposit into the fund the difference between the official  
52 forecast of revenue available for expenditures for Fiscal Year 2011-2012 adopted by the  
53 Revenue Estimating Conference on April 24, 2012, and actual collections of revenue  
54 available for expenditures in Fiscal Year 2011-2012 as promulgated by the Revenue  
55 Estimating Conference, not to exceed the amount of Two Hundred Four Million Seven  
56 Hundred Thousand Dollars. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as  
57 monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on investment of monies in the fund shall  
58 be deposited in and credited to the fund. Except as otherwise provided in this Section,  
59 unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall remain  
60 in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be transferred by the treasurer to the Budget  
61 Stabilization Fund in the state treasury."

13 Tchoupitoulas Street by 773' along Henry Clay Avenue, situated in Section 13, Township  
14 13 S-Range 11E in Orleans Parish, LA, together with all improvements thereon.

15 (2) The Board of Supervisors of Louisiana State University System and  
16 Agricultural and Mechanical College and the Louisiana State University Health Sciences  
17 Center are hereby authorized to enter into such agreements, covenants, conditions, and  
18 stipulations, and to execute such documents as necessary to properly effectuate any  
19 transfer to the property described in subsection A, and as more specifically described in  
20 any such agreements entered into and documents executed by and between the Board of  
21 Supervisors of Louisiana State University System and Agricultural and Mechanical  
22 College and the Louisiana State University Health Sciences Center and the commissioner  
23 of administration.

24 (B)(1) The commissioner of administration, notwithstanding any other provision  
25 of law to the contrary, is hereby authorized and empowered to convey, transfer, assign,  
26 lease or deliver any interest, excluding mineral rights, the state may have to all or any  
27 portion of the parcel of property described in subsection (A)(1) of this Section to the  
28 Children's Hospital, New Orleans.

29 (2) The commissioner of administration is hereby authorized to enter into such  
30 agreements, covenants, conditions, and stipulations, and to execute such documents as  
31 necessary to properly effectuate any conveyance, transfer, assignment, lease, or delivery  
32 of title, excluding mineral rights, to the property described in subsection (A)(1) of this  
33 Section, and as more specifically described in any such agreements entered into and  
34 documents executed by and between the commissioner of administration and Children's  
35 Hospital, New Orleans, in exchange of consideration proportionate to at least the  
36 appraised value of the property.

37 (C) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the state treasurer"
